Does your child speak, move or behave differently than other children the same age?

## Do you have concerns about your preschool child's development?

Renton School District's <u>Child Find</u> provides <u>free</u> developmental screenings through Meadow Crest Early Learning Center for children aged 3-5 years old who reside within the Renton School District boundaries. This screening helps identify possible delays in speech & language, motor, cognitive/learning, self-help or social-emotional development.
