

### 1. Read.

Choose a familiar or favorite story at home or use the links below to books we have read at school.

Before reading ask questions about the book, such as what is the title? what does the author do? what does the illustrator do? Point out parts of the book (author name, illustrators name, cover, back, spine).

After reading students can practice retelling the story:

- Use sticky notes with simple pictures that students can put in order
- Have students name characters.
- Have students say repeating phrases in the story
- Ask what happened first? next? last?
- Ask open ended questions. What do think would happen if...?

#### Differentiation

*Beginning learner:* Ask student to point to pictures in the story, name a character in the story, or describe/demonstrate what is the character doing?

*Experienced learner:* Where is the story taking place? What happens? Draw and label a picture about the story.

### 2. Sequencing practice.

Practice sequencing events while watching television and engaging in daily routines. For example, while watching television ask the student “what happened first?” or ask the student to retell their daily routine using sequencing, when I woke up, first I ..., next I ..., last I....
