

CAPITALS on the Edge

Learning Targets: I can show I know capital letters by moving the capitals to the edge of the table.

Supplies: Capital Letters and lowercase letters, you can print and cut out the cards bellow, make cards or use some you already have

Directions:

1. Scatter 6 to 8 letter cards on the table any side up, facing any direction on the table use a mix of both capital and lowercase letters.
2. Demonstrate with one card how to place the capital around the edge of the table.
3. Have the student put all the capitals around the edge.
4. You admire the capitals around the edge. You and the student "read" them: "Capital B, Capital F Capital Q" Encourage students to join you as you "read" the letters from left to right, let the children point as you say the letters.
5. Mix up the cards and repeat, add more cards if it feels like they need more challenge.
