
Ingredients for learning to read



- Alphabet recognition: identify and label the letters in the alphabet
- Alphabetic principle: understand that letters represent different sounds
- **Phonological awareness:** broad term that includes the ability to identify and manipulate words and chunks of words in addition to specific sounds.
- **Phonemic awareness:** able to identify and manipulate the different sounds in a word.
