

Math Activities: Week 8

*Home activity (Art/Math): Handmade Dominoes

Learning Targets:

I can count the dots on one end of a domino and match it to its numeral.

I can add dots together on both sides of a domino and say the total.

I can name the number of objects in a group by subitizing. Subitizing means to be able to know the amount of a small set of objects without counting.



Directions to make (if you do not have dominoes):

1. Take empty cereal, cracker, dry food boxes (or delivery boxes) & cut into rectangles.

- 2. Using a sharpie draw a line down the middle (horizontal).
- 3. On each side of the line draw dots like on a domino.

4. Have your child count the dots on one side and they have to match it to another domino with the same number of dots.

*Need a challenge? Draw dots on one side and write a number on the other. Your child has to match the number of dots to a corresponding domino with the correct numeral.

*Need a challenge? Simple addition activity. Count the dots on one side of the domino and then the total all together?

*Need a challenge? Have your child look at one side of the domino. Without counting they have to tell you the number of dots they see (subitizing).
