



## Activity: Lower case ABCs: letters, sounds and writing.

*This activity is intended for kids that already can write the alphabet in upper-case and are ready for a challenge!*



### Learning Targets:

- I can recognize and name some letters of the alphabet by singing and point to the letters as I sing.
- I can know I know letter sounds by looking at a letter and saying what sound it makes.
- I can show I know some lowercase letters by naming them.

### Materials Needed:

- White sheets of paper or a notebook.
- A pencil or crayon.

### Directions/Instruction:

1. Watch the video and follow along with Teacher Angy. In this video you we will practice:
  - Singing the ABCs in English and Spanish (no ñ).
  - Phonemic Awareness by changing vowel sounds in a song.
  - Tracing and naming shapes and basic strokes.
  - Tracing letters of the alphabet in lowercase.
  - Matching sounds to letters.
