

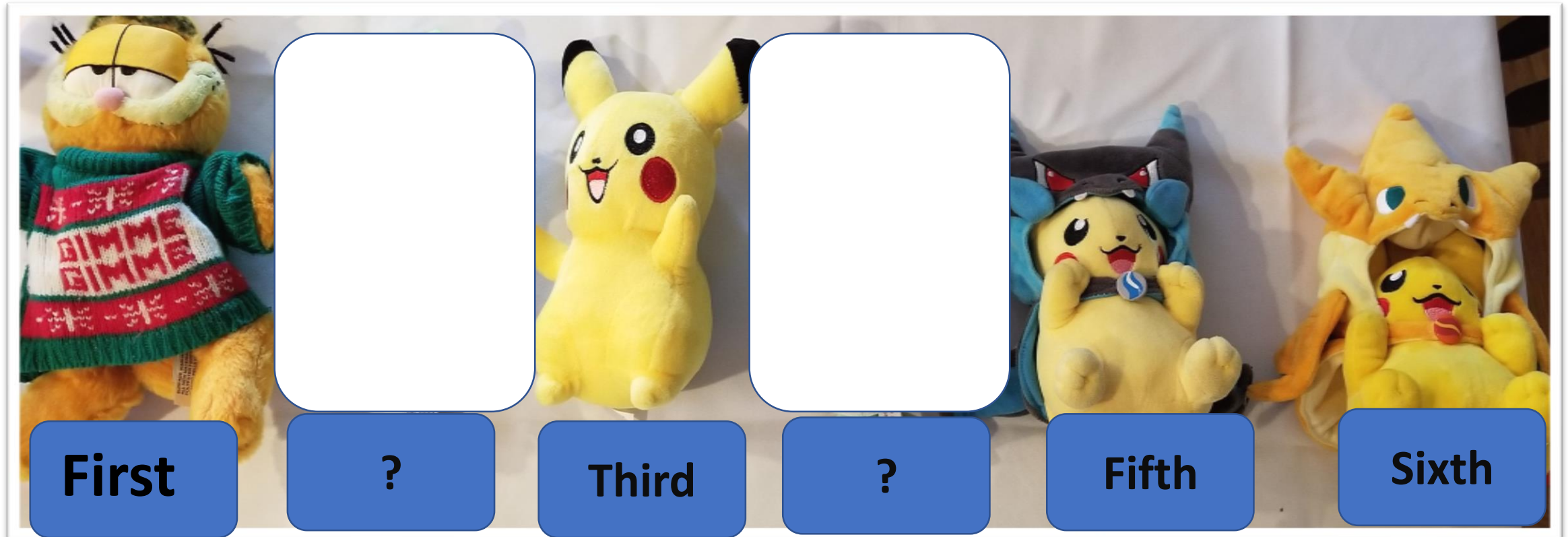
ORDINAL NUMBERS

Learning Targets: “I can recognize the order of objects by using position language like first, second, third, etc.”
“I can match objects to their ordinal position.”



Instructions: Ask your child to gather a collection of six to eight stuff animals or other household items, and ask your child to place them in a line facing the same direction. Have your child tell you which one is first, second, third, fourth, and so on until he/she reaches the end.

For a challenge, remove an animal or two, ask your child to name the missing number. You can also ask your child what comes between first and third? Between third and fifth?

Write the ordinal number (first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth) on a sticky note. Ask your child to look at the order above and match the ordinal number to the correct stuff animal.
